Confirmation & First Holy Communion (& First Reconciliation)

There are seven Catholic sacraments. This form is to be used to register your child for the sacrament(s) of Confirmation or First Holy Communion. To be eligible for the sacrament of

- Confirmation - child must be 15 years old by Feb 1, 2021 and have previously received a Catholic baptism and their first Holy Communion.
- first Holy Communion - child must be 7 years old by September 1, 2020 and have previously received a Catholic baptism

A sacrament is “an outward sign of inward grace, instituted by Christ for our salvation.” Jesus came to save us, and we can be saved *only* if we have a personal relationship with God, and God gave us the seven sacraments as help to our salvation. Every sacrament conveys that help, which we call grace, as a completely unmerited gift. There is nothing we can do to deserve God’s grace.

This year, our programs will start out on a weekly virtual platform with anticipation of being able to be offer a face-to-face classroom environment in the future. With youth it is imperative that we have the parents help to ensure the success of the program. We are so happy to know that the family will benefit from this program just as much as the child that is preparing for their sacrament.
