## FROM THE PASTORAL ASSISTANT'S DESK

#### **A SHORT DEVOTIONAL**

The county fairs have come and gone, football season is here, and the harvest will soon be upon us. Soon, the leaves will begin turning color. This wonderful time of year in NE Ohio can be a busy season for many of us at SPVC. For some of us, including myself, it can become overwhelming and create a great deal of anxiety.

When I begin to get overwhelmed, I often find myself turning to the twelfth chapter of the Gospel of Luke where Jesus talks to his disciples about anxiety. He tells them not to be anxious about anything in their lives. Not what they will eat, not what they will wear, not anything. He tells us that being anxious and worrying cannot do anything for us. Instead, Jesus points to the birds and the field. "Consider the ravens" he tells them, "they neither sow nor reap, they have neither a storehouse nor a barn, and yet God feeds them." He continues, "Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not adorned like one of these."

Indeed, God ensures the birds are fed and clothes the fields. He knows that we need these things too, and He provides them to us. There is a peace in God which surpasses all understanding. It guards our hearts and minds. When we rest and trust in Him, we need not be anxious about anything. Instead, in everything, through prayer and supplication and thanksgiving, we can let our requests, and our worries be made known to God, and we can cast our anxieties on Him.

God has made this promise to us. Don't forget that you can turn to Him and find peace. Life gets busy. The grass withers and the flowers fade away, but the word of the Lord endures forever.

#### **SPVC YOUTH HAPPENINGS**

We've got several things going on with our youth that I'd like everyone to know about. First, and perhaps most exciting for me, is that we officially relaunched our SPVC Youth Ministry last month. Secondly, we recently held an informational meeting with some of our families to discuss establishing a troop of Trail Life USA as a new ministry in our community. I'd like to take a brief moment to share some things about each.

#### **SPVC YOUTH MINISTRY**

Our SPVC Youth Ministry is geared for students in grades 6-12. The focus of our youth ministry is to develop and strengthen the faith of our youth while preparing them to enter adulthood faithfully after graduation. We meet every other Wednesday night from 6:30-8:00 PM in the youth area downstairs. Pizza, wings, and drinks are provided. At each meeting we take time for fellowship, activities, and devotional / bible study. Youth ministry is not just for our youth, but is open to friends, family, and members of the community. If you'd like to know more or have a student in grades 6-12 that you'd like to get involved, please reach out to me directly.

## TRAIL LIFE USA

Trail Life USA is an ecumenical Christian alternative to the Boy Scouts. Currently, we are exploring the possibility of starting a troop as a ministry of SPVC. This ministry is Christ-centered, boy-focused mentoring program that engages boys in service and outdoor adventure to develop godly and courageous leaders. It is structured similarly to the BSA. Right now, we are focusing on our lower grade levels, and planning to start our troop for families with boys in grades K-5. The boys are divided into three patrols: Foxes (K-1), Hawks (2-3) and Mountain Lions (4-5). This ministry is intended to provide our fathers and sons with a unique opportunity to grow in their faith together. Trail Life is both a discipleship program and an evangelical ministry, intended for our youth, friends, family, and members of the community.

For families with daughters, there is a sister organization called American Heritage Girls. If your family is interested in Trail Life USA or American Heritage Girls, please let me know ... especially if you're willing to invest in our children's futures by stepping up as a volunteer or a patrol leader. If you'd like to know more about either organization, please get in touch with me or visit their websites online.

Before we can get our Troop established, we need to get our leadership organized. These positions are at the center of the Troop. Job Descriptions are at the Welcome Center. Once these positions are filled, we will be able to move forward with our charter. The next step is in your hands!

- **Senior Ministry Leader (SML)**: Pastor Zielinski will fill this role. The SML ensures it is an active ministry of the church and is supporting our goals at St. Paul.
- **Troop Ministry Liaison (TML):** Rev. Streeper is the main hands-on staff member. He will coordinate the core leader positions and ensure all the operations of the group are moving forward.
- **Core Leadership** (Needed before we can launch): Committee Chair, Troopmaster, Treasurer, Ranger, and Trail Guides.
  - Committee Chair (CC): He will chair the business meetings of the organization where the various leaders will give reports and planning will take place. While aware of all the activities the Troop is planning, this could be a more "behind the scenes" role.
  - **Troopmaster (TM):** Oversees all "direct contact" leaders (those volunteers who work directly with the boys at each activity), understands all programmatic operations of the Troop, reports successes and challenges faced by leaders and youth. The Troopmaster is the coach of, and Troop Committee representative for the direct contact leaders.
  - **Treasurer:** Manages and reports on the financial status of the Troop; communicates with parents in Troop budgeting; supervises fundraising guidelines; handles funds; and delegates these tasks as needed.

#### **Direct Contact Leaders:**

**Ranger:** (one required, age 21+) This is the leader of the K-5 program (Woodlands Trail) and oversee the operation of specific agelevels within the Troop by providing direction, coaching, and support.

**Trail Guides:** (3 required, age 18+) One leader for each of the 3 levels in Woodlands Trail (Fox (K-1), Hawk (2<sup>nd</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> grades), Mountain Lion (4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grades). They assist the Ranger in delivering the program to the scouts.

Other Committee Members: Advancement Chair, Activities Chair, Membership Chair, Training Chair, Equipment Coordinator, Publicity, Health and Safety, Camping ... whatever positions we see are necessary to have a successful Troop.

Trail Life USA is an evangelistic outreach ministry of our church to serve our community, and to be successful, we need volunteers. As the troop grows and expands, so too will volunteer roles, responsibilities and positions change with it. Whatever capacity you are interested in serving as a volunteer, prayerfully consider it and please get in touch with me.


