
# Distribution

#### Directions


- Ushers will dismiss the congregation beginning from the back of the sanctuary.
- Fill the communion rail beginning from the lectern side (left).
- Kneel or stand as you are able.
- Pastor will distribute the body of Christ followed by the assistants with the blood of Christ (individual or common cup).
- Once you have received the body and blood of Christ, dismiss yourself and return to your seat via the Fellowship Hall through the side door.
- If you have received an individual cup, place it in the basket provided on your way out the door.
- Gluten-free communion bread is available. Simply ask pastor for this option as you come forward for communion.
- A low/no-alcohol option is also available. On the tray of individual cups are several
  plastic cups that contain juice with a drop of wine included. This dilute amount of wine
  uses the element with which the Lord's Supper was instituted (wine) while providing an
  alternative if needed. Please feel free to see Pastor or an Elder if you have any
  questions.

"In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." John 16:33

Perhaps you saw the disheartening news. Ninety-nine (99) people are confirmed dead in the Lahaina fire with only 25% of the area searched.

What message do we bring to those so much in need of care and love?

You have a God who is Emmanuel, (God with us)! He is with you and for you! We are the body of Christ, walking, loving, living, and sharing with those in need.

Pray for the leaders and members of <u>Emmanuel Lutheran, Kahului, Maui</u>. They function as God's hands and feet to the people of Maui. They are Christ's ambassadors and bear the presence of the Savior. Pray for their strength and care as they walk beside many in great need, assisting them, and pointing them towards <u>Hope</u>, found only in Jesus.

What is happening?

- The people of Emmanuel are providing immediate response, sharing needed goods and services, and assisting school families who are housing displaced people.
- Two staff from Lutheran Church Charities are deployed to Maui. They will help to
  organize a response effort able to be sustained by Emmanuel and supported by the CNH
  and the greater LCMS.
- Infusions of relief dollars from your CNH Disaster Fund, LCMS Disaster Relief, local congregations, individual donors, Orphan Grain Train, and LCEF are enabling a growing response.
- We hope to deploy crisis counseling personnel to assist in ministering to survivors and caretakers, sponsored by LCMS Disaster Relief and the CNH.

- Pray for those so horrifically affected, those mourning, and strength for caregivers.
- Encourage those you may know on Maui with texts, cards, and emails. Let them know you are remembering them and praying for them.
- Share a gift to support relief work and recovery.
