## The Lord amidst the Tears

Beloved of the Lord,

The last several weeks have been marked by violent tragedies around our country. These senseless acts of violence have taken the lives of innocents and we weep with their families and loved ones and so does our Lord Jesus. "Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His saints" (Psalm 116:15). Not a single sparrow falls to the ground without His attention and you and these who have died are more precious to Him than many sparrows (Matthew 10:19).

The cries go up: "do something!" And so we do. We do as the Church does: we pray to our Heavenly Father that He would restrain evil, strengthen the protectors, comfort the grieving, heal the wounded, bind up the broken hearted, and make us instruments of these works. We also seek to love our neighbor and help and support them in every physical need.

Within our country there will be vigorous debate over how best to help our neighbors. The question is not whether anyone wants to prevent violence, everyone does and no one welcomes violence of any sort. The debate will be over what to do in light of these tragedies—and in light of all violence. As Christians we are free to engage in these debates and discussions and then vote our conscience as it is informed and ruled by our faith. We are not free to vilify those who disagree with us or project evil motives on those who offer different solutions or debate what we may think is best. We keep the 8<sup>th</sup> Commandment (to defend our neighbor's reputation) as dutifully as we strive to keep the 5<sup>th</sup> (to defend our neighbor's life). We respect the earthly laws and rulers which God has established and encourage our leaders and neighbors to likewise respect them and work within them.

As we pray, we indeed accomplish much. Do not listen to the critics who demean our prayers. If they do not appreciate the power of prayer, then they underestimate the power and graciousness of God. Pray for them as well. Pray for our enemies, those who persecute us, and those who are harmed by sin in this world. Pray that they would come to the knowledge of the love of God in Christ Jesus, to repentance, and to forgiveness that Christ has won and that comforts us amidst our tears of sorrow.



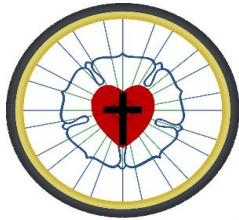
